If not, the General Data Protection Regulation can be likened to an up-to-date version of the Data Protection Act. When the first data protection laws were introduced in 1998, Google didn't even exist. The GDPR recognises that our world - and the way our personal data is processed - has changed significantly in the last two decades. **General Data Protection regulations come into effect on 25th May 2018** and is a European Union initiative to ensure that organisations and companies that collect data about people ensure that they collect it fairly and legally and that all information is kept securely. A Privacy Notice is being sent home with your child today to provide you with some more information about what we do with your personal information. Please read it and return it to school as soon as possible - thank you.
