

Base 2 Overview: Summer Term 1.

Literacy: This half-term we will be exploring & writing narrative texts. We will be concentrating on using different sentence structures to add descriptive details & extend our writing. We will also be focusing on improving our inference & deduction skills to improve both our writing & reading comprehension.

Numeracy: Our focus this half-term will be on understanding place value & fractions (proper, improper, mixed & decimal). This will include ordering fractions, finding equivalent, calculating with fractions & simplifying the answers. The children's homework will continue to focus on recalling multiplication & division facts & applying these in different contexts.

History: This half-term our History topic will be the Victorian era. The children will be investigating what it was like to be a child in Victorian times - their working lives, homes & schools. We will also be finding out about significant events & people from the Victorian period & considering how they have affected our lives today.

Art: Having worked hard at drawing pencil portraits of family members & friends last term, the children will now be using pastels to extend their portraiture skills.
